2024 Dance Auditions:

Auditions will be held in week 3 of term 1. Please note that the tutors' decision will be final. There will be an audition process for each troupe except for the Performance Troupe and the Technique class. The performance troupe is a troupe we have designed so that every dancer can be a part of a troupe. If your child auditions for a specialised troupe (eg. Lyrical, Jazz, Contemporary) and they don't get in, we will place them into the performance troupe. This troupe will also do competitions. The Technique class is a class that we will offer for dancers to work on and improve their technique and flexibility. Expectations for dancers:

Dancers are expected to be on time and present for each dance class. It is your child's responsibility to remember when their dance class is and what time. If your child misses more than 2 classes in a row without a valid reason, this could jeopardise their position in their troupe and there will be no refund.

2024 Competition/Event Dates:

As the Dance Programme gets underway we will firm up which competitions we will enter. Please note we will not do all competitions and it will be up to the tutors as to what competitions each troupe enters. We will give you plenty of notice as to what competitions your child will be entering. This is largely dependent on the group's readiness to compete. If your child cannot make a competition for a valid reason, please note they will not be penalised for this. Parents are responsible for transport and supervision on competition days along with accommodation should it be an overnight event. Should this be the case, plenty of notice and further details will be provided well ahead of time. We will also have the RI Extravaganza which will be held in the Remuera Intermediate School Hall in Term 4. This is our dance showcase that we host for all of the other students and we welcome friends and family to come along as we showcase all our amazing dancers.

Fees:

There is a one-off yearly fee of **\$400 per student for each troupe they take part in**. This fee must be paid in advance for students to participate in the groups. It covers outside tutors' wages, weekend workshops, etc.

Please note: as these fees are based on the number of students accepted into each group, if a student drops out of a group, no refunds can be made.

To confirm a place please pay the fee which will be invoiced for the fee via the parent portal. All payments must be made no later than **Friday 23rd February**. No students will be permitted to participate in any troupe until payment is made in full. If this is not paid in full by this date they will lose their spot, which will go to the next child on the waiting list. Classes will commence as per the attached dates and times.
