

Netball Trials 2024

Information for Parents

Dear Parents/Caregivers,

Welcome to the start of the 2024 Netball season. We are looking forward to another exciting year of action on the courts. Please take time to read the information below and complete the attached form to give permission for your child to attend the upcoming netball trials for 2024. Please <u>fill in the google form by Monday, March 6th.</u> No form, no trial, no exceptions.

Once trials are completed, teams will be notified and full details regarding fee payments and uniform purchasing will be provided along with the contact details of other members in the team. Please read the information below before confirming your child's participation in the upcoming trials. Players will be placed in teams based on a trial. We can not guarantee that girls will be placed with friends or graded the same as last year. Teams need a minimum of 10 girls to commit to be entered in the comp.

Thursday 7 March 7.30 – 8.30 am.

Call Backs if required will be at lunchtime.

Competition Venue: Auckland Netball Centre, Alison Fergusson Drive, St Johns

Competition Day: Tuesday Afternoons/Evenings. Start in Term 2 - May 7 / Finish in Term 3 - August 27

Start Times: Start times range from 4 pm-7 pm TBC Weekly

Competition Format Year 7 and 8 netball is a 7 by 7 format as detailed in this handout. It is recommended that

students have some awareness of the positions and playing areas prior to the trial,

especially for intermediate and experienced players.

Umpires: Each team will need to provide an umpire to umpire their games. Managers will be

responsible for contacting the umpire each week with match details. If an umpire is unable to make it due to sickness, a replacement can be made from the school pool of

umpires.

Transport: Parents/Players are responsible for organising transport to and from the courts

Training Times: These will be set once teams are created and will be based on the manager/coach

availability.

Uniform: RI Netball Uniforms for all players are available for purchase directly through the

Uniform Shop in Remuera (Dress/Bike Pants). Samples will be available at school for sizing along with measurements on the Uniform Shop website. We do have a limited

stock of netball uniforms for hire, a first come first serve basis.

Player Fees: The fee for the season is \$95 per person which includes registration, umpires fees and

equipment for each team. This must be paid in full through the school portal or at the

office by Mon 2 April and is not required to be paid until after trials. (Subject to

change, depending on registration costs)

Coaches/Managers: Each team is responsible for arranging their own coach and manager. ANC run a coaching

programme. All coaches are recommended to attend this.

Pre-Season Tournament

There is a pre-season tournament on **Sunday 5 May** (entries close 26 April) Managers will be responsible for checking on the availability of their team. If keen, teams (via the manager) will need to arrange their own registration, costs and umpire for the event. **This is not included in the players' fees.**

Please Note: Teams will only be registered once all members have paid in full and a coach, manager and umpire have been confirmed.
