

# **Remuera Intermediate Sports Programme**

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

RI offers various sporting opportunities for students to participate at a social level as well as the elite competitive level both within the school day and out of school hours.

#### **Central Zone Teams**

As the year progresses, students will be informed via daily notices of various sporting teams which represent R.I. against other teams in the central zone. Most teams receive a large amount of interest and the teacher in charge of the event will run trials to select a team to represent RI at the central zone competition day. If teams win this competition they will be sent to represent R.I and the Central Zone at Interzone competition with teams from all over the wider Auckland area.

#### **RI Referees**

R.I. Referees run lunchtime sport. Competitions last year included touch, dodgeball and netball. Students who are interested in becoming a referee apply and trial for the position at the beginning of the year.

### **Lunchtime Sport**

Lunchtime sport is a range of competitions that any individual can participate in. Previously we have had inter-class competitions and competitions where students can form their own team to participate in.

#### **Basketball Coaching and Games (Trials in Term 1)**

Basketball coaching is run by 'Swished on'. They teach skills, improve their game as well as fostering a passion for basketball. Students are also placed in a team and they play in a competition with other schools. Games are held at St Kent's on a Wednesday or Barfoot & Thompson stadium on a Thursday between 4 and 7 pm. Teams play in A, B, C or Social grades. More details and registration will be sent out separately.

#### Netball Coaching and Tuesday Games (Trials in Term 1)

Students are placed in teams during term one. Teams organise their own coach, manager and umpire. Teams run their own coaching sessions at school at a time that suits the team. A coaching and umpiring course is run by Auckland Netball at the beginning of the year.

Games are held either 4 pm, 5 pm or 6 pm at Auckland Netball Centre, St Johns. More details and registration will be sent out separately.

#### AIMS Games 2024

Students attended the AIMS games in 2023 representing RI in Boys Futsal, Boys Basketball, Netball, Rock Climbing, Swimming, and Cross Country.

More information and registration for the 2024 games will follow. Registrations will need to be completed by the end of Term 1 to be considered.

## **Sports Monitors**

Each class has a Sports Monitor that is responsible for organising class PE gear and running the PE shed. Monitors are selected in class during term 1. Interested students make an application to explain why they would be successful in the role.
